



Code of Conduct

1. **The use of alcohol, drugs, tobacco, and any other illegal or inappropriate substance by campers is prohibited.** Violations will be considered justification for immediate expulsion from the Camp without refund.
2. Campers are not allowed to bring weapons or any other inappropriate items to camp. Any items found will be confiscated and calls to parents made.
3. Inappropriate language will not be tolerated.
4. Campers are expected to follow the rules set forth at the camp director's meeting on the first evening.
5. **Campers are not permitted in rooms or suites occupied by people of the opposite sex at any time. Violation will result in expulsion from camp without refund.**
6. A curfew procedure will be explained to the campers at an orientation meeting on the first day of camp. It will be enforced without exception. Absence from their room at bed check without supervision of a staff member is a serious matter and will be handled by the camp director.
7. As a courtesy to fellow campers and to other hotel guests, loud and boisterous activity will not be tolerated. Quiet hours will be established and enforced. Campers are allowed only on the swim camp floors. All other floors, except common areas, i.e., lobby, eating area, etc. are off limits. The camp floors are off limits to visitors.
8. Campers must keep their rooms clean and in good order. Campers and their parents will be held responsible for any damage to rooms and furnishings, and payment for such damage will be billed to the parents. In cases where damage is incurred by a group, the person(s) directly involved along with each member of the group will be responsible for an equal portion of the damage. Campers should report any problems to a staff member.
9. Campers are expected to dress sensibly and appropriately at all times. Shirts, shorts, and shoes must be worn at the natatorium, on all touring and activities, and in and around the hotel.
10. Campers are expected to show courtesy toward fellow campers, other swimmers and staff at the natatorium, the hotel staff, and the Camp staff.
11. Campers are required attend all camp sessions, tours, activities and be on time for roll call. If a camper is ill they should contact a staff member immediately.
12. In order to provide a pleasant environment and to ensure the safety of our campers and staff, disruptive, destructive and/or dangerous behavior by campers is NOT ALLOWED. Such behavior will result in the camper being removed from that activity. If the behavior continues, the camper will be dismissed from the camp. When a participant is dismissed from camp for unacceptable behavior there will be NO REFUND.



13. If a camper's behavior is consistently and severely at odds with the Camp's rules and regulations, he/she will be sent home. Parents will be notified and required to make all necessary transportation arrangements for an immediate return home at their expense. There will be no refunds or credit or fees from the Camp under these circumstances.

14. Theft and vandalism will not be tolerated. We are guests at the hotel and natatorium and property must be treated with respect. Champions Swim & Travel Experience will not be liable for any lost, stolen or damaged property. Any valuables brought to camp are assumed responsibility of the camper.

I understand the above rules, and agree to follow additional rules explained to me when I arrive at camp. I understand that violation of the Camp's rules and regulations can result in my immediate expulsion from camp without refund.
